## II. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

5. Venue is proper in Montgomery County, Texas, because a substantial part of the actions sought to be enjoined will occur in Montgomery County, a substantial part of the facts giving rise hereto occurred in Montgomery County, and Plaintiffs are residents of Bandera County, Texas, and were at the time the causes of action asserted herein accrued. TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 15.002.

6. This Court has jurisdiction over this cause of action pursuant to Article V, § 8 of the Texas Constitution and Texas Election Code § 273.081 which provides that a “person who is

being harmed or is in danger of being harmed by a violation or threatened violation of this code is entitled to appropriate injunctive relief to prevent the violation from continuing or occurring.” Plaintiffs have standing to bring this as the elected party officers harmed by Defendant’s violation of Section 171.054, Texas Election Code, and Republican Party of Texas Rule 29

### **III. DISCOVERY AND CONTROL PLAN LEVEL**

7. Plaintiffs intend to conduct discovery under Level 3 of Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 190.4 and affirmatively pleads that this suit is not governed by the expedited actions process in Texas Rule of Civil Procedure because Plaintiffs request injunctive relief.

### **IV. CLAIM FOR RELIEF**

8. Plaintiffs seek only nonmonetary relief.

### **V. FACTS**

9. Texas Election Code §171.154(a) provides that “The district executive committee for a district situated in more than one county consists of the members of each county executive committee who reside in the district.”

10. Texas Election Code §171.022(a) states that the members of each county executive committee are:

(1) a county chair, who is the presiding officer, elected at the general primary election by majority vote of the qualified voters of the county who vote in the primary on that office or appointed by the county executive committee as provided by this subchapter; and

(2) a precinct chair from each county election precinct, elected at the general primary by majority vote of the qualified voters of the precinct who vote in the primary on that office, subject to Section 171.0221, or appointed by the county executive committee as provided

by this subchapter.

11. The members of the Montgomery County Republican Executive Committee are County Chair Bryan Christ and those precinct chairs elected in the general primary election or appointed to fill vacancies as indicated on the official list published by the Texas Secretary of State and included as Exhibit A.

12. Defendants are not named on the official list of precinct chairs in Exhibit A, and are not members of the senate district executive committees of the Republican Party in Montgomery County, Texas. Moreover, Bob Bagley, Bill Philibert, Mariann Siegert, Susan Love, Brigetta Millen, Mary Lewis, Sherry Tavel, Stephanie Cox, Lonna Hord, Jackie Williams, and Patrick Teich have filed sworn ballot applications with Chair Christ to run for party office where they stated they are not incumbents. Exhibit B.

13. On December 2, 2023, Republican Party of Texas Chair Matt Rinaldi called senate district executive committee meetings to be held December 5, 2023 for the purpose of electing a senate district executive committee chair for each district. Exhibit C.

14. On August 14, 2023, Defendants Caleb Smith, Lauren Vickers, Bill Philibert, Jim Doyle, Mariann Siegert, Gwen Withrow, Steven Foster, Susan Love, Brigetta Millen, Mary Lewis, Sherry Tavel, Stephanie Cox, Stephanie Schwantes, Lonna Hord, Jackie Williams, and Patrick Teich purported to caucus for the purpose of electing senate district executive committee chairs, despite their not being precinct chairs or senate district executive committee members.

15. Defendants have previously asserted falsely to the Texas Supreme Court that they are precinct chairs in an attempt to have the Court issue a writ of mandamus to have them listed as

precinct chairs. *In re The MoCo Precinct Chair Group*, No. 23-1027 (Tex. 2023). The Texas Supreme Court denied their petition on June 23, 2023, and denied their motion for rehearing on August 11, 2023. *Id.*

16. Unless enjoined by this Court, Defendants will, as they tried in August, attempt to participate in the election of senate district executive committee chairs despite not being members of the senate district executive committees in Montgomery County.

17. The senate district executive committees of each political party fulfill an important public purpose of filling vacancies in nomination for public office, and organize senatorial district conventions. Tex. Elec. Code §§ 145.036, 171.054, 174.065. These conventions nominate delegates to the state convention caucuses that name those national delegates that elect nominees for president and vice president of the United States, fulfilling an important public purpose of fulfilling the will of Texas primary election voters to nominate their candidates of choice for these high public offices.

18. Plaintiff seeks a declaration from the Court that Defendants are not Republican precinct chairs or members of the Republican senate district executive committees in Montgomery County, Texas. Plaintiffs additionally seek a temporary restraining order and temporary injunction to enjoin persons other than legitimate members of these bodies from conducting business pursuant to Texas Election Code §171.054.

19. Plaintiffs will suffer immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage if persons other than legitimate members of the senate district executive committees are not enjoined from conducting official business as members at the December 5, 2023 senate district executive committee meetings, and future meetings, as their lawful votes will be diluted, their meetings will

be subject to continued disruption, and the legitimate public business described above will be frustrated. Plaintiffs do not have an adequate remedy at law because the initial meeting is called for December 5, 2023. Plaintiffs have exercised due diligence in prosecuting this claim, as the call was issued only two business days prior to the meeting. The injury to Plaintiffs if Defendants continue their conduct described above would outweigh any injury the restraining order and injunction might cause Defendant, and issuance of the restraining order and injunction would not disserve the public interest.

20. *Conditions Precedent.* All conditions precedent have been performed or have occurred.

21. Enjoining Defendants violation of the Texas Election Code necessitates holding a hearing prior to providing notice to Defendant of this application. Plaintiffs made diligent efforts to notify Defendants of the hearing on the TRO.

#### **VI. APPLICATION FOR DECLARATORY RELIEF**

22. Plaintiff incorporates all of the paragraphs above and below.

23. There exists a genuine controversy between the parties herein that would be terminated by the granting of declaratory judgment. Plaintiffs therefore request that declaratory judgment be entered that Defendants are not incumbent precinct chairs in Montgomery County, Texas, and are not members of senate district executive committees in Montgomery County, Texas.

#### **VII. ATTORNEY'S FEES**

24. Pursuant to Section 37.009 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, request is made for all costs and reasonable and necessary attorney's fees incurred by Plaintiffs herein,

including all fees necessary in the event of an appeal of this cause to the Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court of Texas, as the Court deems equitable and just.

**VIII. APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY INJUNCTION**

25. Plaintiff incorporates all of the paragraphs above and below.

26. As reflected above, Defendant's wrongful acts have caused, and are continuing to cause, harm to Plaintiffs, who have no adequate remedy at law. Plaintiffs have established a substantial likelihood of success on the merits in this matter. Plaintiffs have shown herein that Defendants, if not restricted, will illegitimately conduct business as members of Montgomery County senate district executive committees and dilute, disrupt, and otherwise thwart the important public business of these committees. Plaintiffs ask this Court to enter a temporary injunction, until such time as there is a trial on the merits, and after a trial on the merits, requiring Defendants and their agents, assigns, or representatives who receive actual notice of this Court's order by personal service, telecopy, e-mail or otherwise to not conduct official business under the color of lawful membership in a senate district executive committee in Montgomery County, Texas.

**PRAYER**

**WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED,** Plaintiffs pray that the Defendant be cited to appear, and answer herein, and that upon final trial hereof the Plaintiffs will have judgment against the Defendant for the following:

- a. Temporary Restraining Order;
- b. Temporary Injunction;
- c. Declaratory Judgment;
- d. Court costs;
- e. Attorney's fees; and



- f. All other remedies at law and in equity that Plaintiffs may show themselves justly entitled.


facilitating the selection of nominating delegates to the state convention caucus, which will in turn name national delegates that elect nominees for President and Vice President of the United States.
